二、稿件要求

2. 标题自拟, 字数要求: 中文、英文稿件均不少于2000字; 请附上3-5张高清相关照片(单张1MB以上, 内容可为人像、场景、故事瞬间等)及100字左右的个人简介(注明国籍、职业/身份、在华时长)。

3. 稿件需为原创未发表作品, 严禁抄袭、洗稿, 若涉及事实性内容(如事件、数据、机构名称)请确保准确无误, 本刊对稿件拥有编辑、排版及新媒体推送权。

4. Chinese Culture and People: Talk freely about Chinese culture (traditional customs, food culture, values, etc.) in your eyes and its unique charm that attracts you, or share the touching interactions with your Chinese colleagues, neighbors, and friends to convey the warmth of cross-cultural encounters.

II. Submission Guidelines

1. The article shall be a first-person narrative (in either Chinese or English), containing real experiences and genuine emotions, with vivid writing and strong readability that will resonate with readers emotionally.

2. Title to be self-designed. Word count requirement: Both Chinese and English manuscripts shall be no less than 2,000 words. Please attach 3-5 high-definition relevant photos (each over 1MB, and may be either a portrait, a site visit, scenery visit, story moments, etc.) and a brief personal profile (about 100 words, indicating nationality, occupation/identity, and duration of stay in China).

3. Manuscripts must be original and unpublished works. Plagiarism and text rewriting are strictly prohibited. For factual content (such as events, data, and institutional names), please ensure accuracy. The magazine reserves the right to edit, typeset, and publish the manuscripts on new media platforms.
